Experience

For twenty years after graduating from West Virginia University, the subject worked as the manager of engineering for two coal companies. For the last eight years, Altizer has owned and managed an engineering consulting and surveying company. In addition, he is currently Managing Member and General Manager of a land holding company which has title to a 10, 500 acre fee tract containing coal and timber in Leslie and Perry Counties, Kentucky.

Highlights of Altizer's experience in the mining industry include:

- Engineering coordinator and supervisor for the installation of a three million ton per year facility in Jeff, Kentucky. The project included construction of a 400 ft high rock and earth dam for coal refuse disposal, a heavy media with heavy media cyclones preparation plant, a batch weigh unit train loadout with three stage automatic coal sampling, a unit train sidetrack with excavation and three mines, two drift and one slope.
